Sawyer AFB, Michigan, as a Captain in the Base Staff Judge Advocate's office. Positions held included, senior Assistant Staff Judge Advocate, Claims Officer, and Prosecutor (Trial Counsel) in Special Courts Martial, Legal Advisor to numerous administrative boards including boards convened at other AF installments. After active service, served two years in inactive reserves and thereafter received an honorable discharge.

- A. This period of law practice included serving approximately one and one-half years as Assistant County Attorney of Kerr County, Texas from mid 1978 to late 1979 ; and
- B. Approximately three years as Justice of the Peace, Precinct 1, Kerr County, Texas from 1980 through 1982;

4. The Kerrville Telephone Company, Kerrville, Texas:

Senior Vice President and General Counsel with executive responsibility for all Kerrville Telephone Company (KTC) activities which were not regulated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas, including all managerial decisions in implementing the startup and operation of the company's cellular telephone entity (Texas RSA 15B2 Limited Partnership, d/b/a Five Star Wireless), the company's participation in providing satellite television service, the company's microwave transmission facilities, security alarm business, equipment sales and business telephone system sales, as well as acting as General Counsel for the company and representing the company in most matters other than those before the Public Utility Commission of Texas, in which outside counsel was retained. Employed from April 1990 to April 2003.

5. April 2003 to present: Dealing with family business interest, including land sales in Kerr and Brazoria Counties and ranching in Kerr County.

While working in the cellular telephone business for Kerrville Telephone Company, served on the Regulatory Affairs Committee for the Rural Cellular Association, a national association of smaller independent cellular network providers, for approximately four years, serving as chairman for two years in the late 90's and early 2000's. In this capacity, I did make trips to Washington to discuss matters of interest to this group with FCC staff and individual commissioners as well as members of the U. S. House of Representatives and Senators, or their staffs. I was not a registered lobbyist.
5. Also while working at The Kerrville Telephone Company, I served on the national advisory committee of the National Rural Telecommunications Cooperative in Washington, D.C., regarding its member companies' participation with DirecTv in providing DirecTv satellite television services to their respective customers in rural America.
6. President, Kerr County Bar Association for one year during the 1980's.

### **Public Service:**

1. Member of the Board of Trustees of the Hal and Charlie Peterson Foundation, Kerrville, Texas from October 1985 to the present, serving as Board President from February 1993 to the present. The Hal and Charlie Peterson Foundation is a private foundation established by the Peterson brothers in the mid 1940's which thereafter established as its mission the building and operating of a charitable hospital in Kerr County, Texas, the Sid Peterson Memorial Hospital. The hospital was operated by the foundation until January 1, 1990, when it was spun off as an entity entirely separate from the Foundation. Since that time, the Foundation has engaged only in charitable support of Sec. 501(c)(3) and other qualifying organizations.
2. Served on several committees appointed by the City of Kerrville City Counsel and the Kerr County Commissioners' Court, including the "Goals for the 80's Committee" and a committee to study the then current Kerr County jail utilization and future needs.
3. Coached several youth sports, including baseball, soccer and basketball, for various periods up to 14 years in the case Little League baseball.
4. Served on the Tivy Athletic Booster Club board for approximately 10 years, serving as president in the 1992-1993 year.
